





This letter explains the determinations made on your land. The 1990 Farm Bill states that all farms must be evaluated by the Soil Conservation Service for Highly Erodible Land and Wetland areas. The law requires a plan to be developed to control erosion on Highly Erodible fields (HEL) and limits the development of areas considered wetlands.

There is a definition page attached to explain the abbreviations used on the map. Numbers in this letter refer to the attached determination.

Review your determination carefully as it may be an evaluation for Highly Erodible land, Wetlands, or both. Keep this determination as it is your record for future years. If you are the operator, please inform the owner of the determination or if you are the owner, inform your operator.

Fields listed in blocks 8 and 9 are Highly Erodible and must have a conservation plan. Fields listed in block 8 must have a conservation plan within 2 years of being soils mapped. Fields listed in block 9 must have a conservation plan before a commodity crop can be planted.

The 1990 Farm Bill has brought a significant change in the definition of a converted wetland, "CW". Any Wetland, "W", that is altered or manipulated for the production of an agricultural commodity after November 28, 1990, the signing of the 1990 Farm Bill, may result in the loss of USDA farm program benefits regardless of whether an annually seeded commodity crop is planted. This is a change from the 1985 Farm Bill which allowed the conversion of Wetlands to cropland without violation, provided the area was not planted to an annually seeded commodity crop. Refer to blocks 21 and 22.

Fields listed on block 12 have areas considered as Wetlands for farm bill purposes only. Some of these areas may have been partially drained in the past. If this applies to any of your land, you need to complete a drainage worksheet available in our office. Drainage in Farmed Wetlands, "FW" or "FWP", may be maintained but not improved.

If you disagree with this determination you must send a written appeal to this office within 15 days stating why you disagree.

This determination is based on information you certified on the Highly Erodible Land Wetland Conservation form at the ASCS Office. Please contact ASCS to verify if all forms have been completed in order to receive program benefits.
