It is agreed that if this contract covers less than ten (10) acres of land, and in the event of the foreclosure of this contract and sale of property by sheriff's sale in such foreclosure proceedings, the time of one year for redemption from said sale provided by the statutes of State of Iowa shall be reduced to six (6) months provided the Sellers, in such action file an election to waive any deficiency judgment aga Buyers which may arise out of the foreclosure proceedings; all to be consistent with the provisions of Chapter 628 of the Iowa Code. It redemption period is so reduced, for the first three (3) months after sale such right of redemption shall be exclusive to the Buyers, and time periods in Sections 628.5, 628.15 and 628.16 of the Iowa Code shall be reduced to four (4) months.   - d. Buyers and Sellers are also entitled to utilize any and all other remedies or actions at law or in equity available to them.
- e. In any action or proceeding relating to this contract the successful party shall be entitled to receive reasonable attorney's fees and costs as permitted by law.
- 12. JOINT TENANCY IN PROCEEDS AND IN REAL ESTATE. If Sellers, immediately preceding this contract, hold title to the Real Estate in joint tenancy with full right of survivorship, and the joint tenancy is not later destroyed by operation of law or by acts of Sellers, then the proceeds of this sale, and any continuing or recaptured rights of Sellers in the Real Estate, shall belong to Sellers as joint tenants with full right of survivorship and not as tenants in common; and Buyers, in the event of the death of either Seller, agree to pay any balance of the price due Sellers under this contract to the surviving Seller and to accept a deed from the surviving Seller consistent with paragraph 10.
- 13. JOINDER BY SELLER'S SPOUSE. Seller's spouse, if not a titleholder immediately preceding acceptance of this offer, executes this contract only for the purpose of relinquishing all rights of dower, homestead and distributive shares or in compliance with Section 561.13 of the lowa Code and agrees to execute the deed for this purpose.
- 14. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE. Time is of the essence in this contract.
- **15. PERSONAL PROPERTY.** If this contract includes the sale of any personal property, Buyers grant the Sellers a security interest in the personal property and Buyers shall execute the necessary financing statements and deliver them to Sellers.
- **16. CONSTRUCTION.** Words and phrases in this contract shall be construed as in the singular or plural number, and as masculine, feminine or neuter gender, according to the context.
- 17. RELEASE OF RIGHTS. Each of the Sellers hereby relinquishes all rights of dower, homestead and distributive share in and to the property and waives all rights of exemption as to any of the property.
- 18. CERTIFICATION. Buyers and Sellers each certify that they are not acting, directly or indirectly, for or on behalf of any person, group, entity or nation named by any Executive Order or the United States Treasury Department as a terrorist, "Specially Designated National and Blocked Person" or any other banned or blocked person, entity, nation or transaction pursuant to any law, order, rule or regulation that is enforced or administered by the Office of Foreign Assets Control; and are not engaged in this transaction, directly or indirectly on behalf of, any such person, group, entity or nation. Each party hereby agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the other party from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, risks, liabilities and expenses (including attorney's fees and costs) arising from or related to my breach of the foregoing certification.

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#### Addendum for Inspection of Private Sewage Disposal System

Buyer and Seller agree on the following initialed alternative to comply with the time of transfer inspection of private sewage disposal systems: There is a private sewage disposal system on this Property which serves the Property. Seller has obtained. or shall obtain at Seller's expense within \_\_\_ days a certified inspector's report which documents the condition of the private sewage disposal system, that it is of sufficient capacity to serve the Property, that the continued use of the system is permitted, and whether any modifications are required to conform to standards adopted by the Department of Natural Resources. Seller shall attach the inspection report to the Groundwater Hazard Statement to be filed at closing. If Seller receives an unsatisfactory report, the basis of which cannot be resolved between Buyer and Seller within days of delivery of a copy to Buyer, then upon written notice from Buyer to Seller, this agreement shall be null and void and all earnest money paid hereunder shall be returned immediately to Buyer. There is a private sewage disposal system on this Property. Weather or other temporary physical conditions. prevent the certified inspection of the private sewage disposal system from being conducted. Buyer shall execute a binding acknowledgment with the County Board of Health to conduct a certified inspection of the private sewage disposal system at the earliest practicable time and to be responsible for any required modifications to the private sewage disposal system as identified by the certified inspection. Buyer shall attach a copy of the binding acknowledgment to the Groundwater Hazard Statement to be filed at closing. When the inspection is completed, an amended Groundwater Hazard Statement shall be filed with the certified inspection and shall include the document numbers of both the real estate transfer document and the original Groundwater Hazard Statement Seller agrees at closing to deposit the sum of \$ Dollars into escrow with ("Escrow Agent") to reimburse Buyer for expenses incurred for the cost of the inspection and any required modifications to the private disposal system. Escrow Agent shall pay to Buyer, up to the amount held in escrow, amounts for required modifications after any such modifications are completed and upon submission to Escrow Agent of a detailed invoice. If no modifications are required, the entire escrow account shall be returned to Seller. Any funds remaining in the escrow account after any required modifications shall be returned to Seller. Seller shall not be responsible for any cost in excess of the escrow deposit. There is a private sewage disposal system on this Property. The building to which the sewage disposal. system is connected will be demolished without being occupied. Buyer shall execute a binding acknowledgement with the county board of health to demolish the building within an agreed upon time period. Buyer shall attach a copy of the binding acknowledgement to the Groundwater Hazard Statement to

1. Court Officer & Trustee Warranty Deed

#### Addendum - Additional provisions

#### **SPECIAL PROVISIONS:**

• Tracts 1-6 are selling subject to tenant's rights on the tillable land for the 2024 farming season. Buyer will receive the second half cash rent payment due September 1, 2024, from the tenant as follows:

Tract 1 = \$6,377.60, Tract 2 = \$3,543.11, Tract 3 = \$6,481.31, Tract 4 = \$11,220.22, Tract 5 = \$2,461.82, Tract 6 = \$3,079.70

- Seller has served termination to the tenant, therefore the land will be selling free and clear for the 2025 farming season.
- It shall be the obligation of the Buyer to report to the Jefferson County FSA office and show filed deed in order to receive the following if applicable: A. Allotted base acres. B. Any future government programs. C. CRP Prorate.
- Buyer agrees to follow all requirements of conservation plans and practices required by the FSA to maintain eligibility in the Conservation Reserve Program. Buyer agrees to accept responsibility and liability for any actions by the Buyer which would endanger eligibility for the CRP or actions that would require repayment of the CRP payment or payments. Buyer further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Sellers for any recovery sought by the FSA due to actions of Buyer, which would violate the requirements of the CRP.
- Tracts 3 & 4 will be surveyed by a licensed surveyor, at Seller's expense. Tracts 3 & 4 will be sold by the acre with gross surveyed acres being the multiplier used to determine the total bid amount. In the event the final survey is not completed by auction day or if the recorded survey is different than the announced gross surveyed acres, adjustments to the final contract price will be made accordingly at final settlement/closing only on Tracts 3 & 4, where the gross surveyed acres were used for the multiplier.
- It shall be the responsibility and expense of the Buyers of Tracts 3 & 4 to separate off the electric from the homestead not selling and install a separate electric meter, if needed or desired.
- There shall be a water easement/agreement established for the well located on Tract 4 for the homestead not selling. Tract 3 will not have water rights to the well on Tract 4. Rural water is in the area.
- Tract 3 has a septic drainage & maintenance easement in favor of the adjacent homestead not selling.
- This real estate auction is selling subject to final approval of the survey and subdivision requirements of the county.
- If one Buyer purchases more than one tract, the Seller shall only be obligated to furnish one abstract and deed (husband & wife constitute one Buyer).
- This auction sale is not contingent upon Buyer's financing or any other Buyer contingencies.
- If a Buyer is unable to close due to insufficient funds or otherwise, Buyer will be in default and the deposit money will be forfeited.
- The Buyer shall be responsible for any fencing in accordance with state law.

- The Buyer shall be responsible for installing his/her own entrances if needed or desired.
- If in the future a site clean-up is required, it shall be at the expense of the Buyer.
- All mineral rights, if any, held by Seller will be transferred to Buyer upon closing.
- This real estate is selling subject to any and all covenants, restrictions, encroachments and easements, as well as all applicable zoning laws.
- All lines, drawings, boundaries, dimensions and descriptions are approximations only based upon the best information available and are subject to possible variation.
