Determination applies to areas delineated on the accompanying photos. Some ditches may have been in place since 1984. Wetland characteristics still show up.

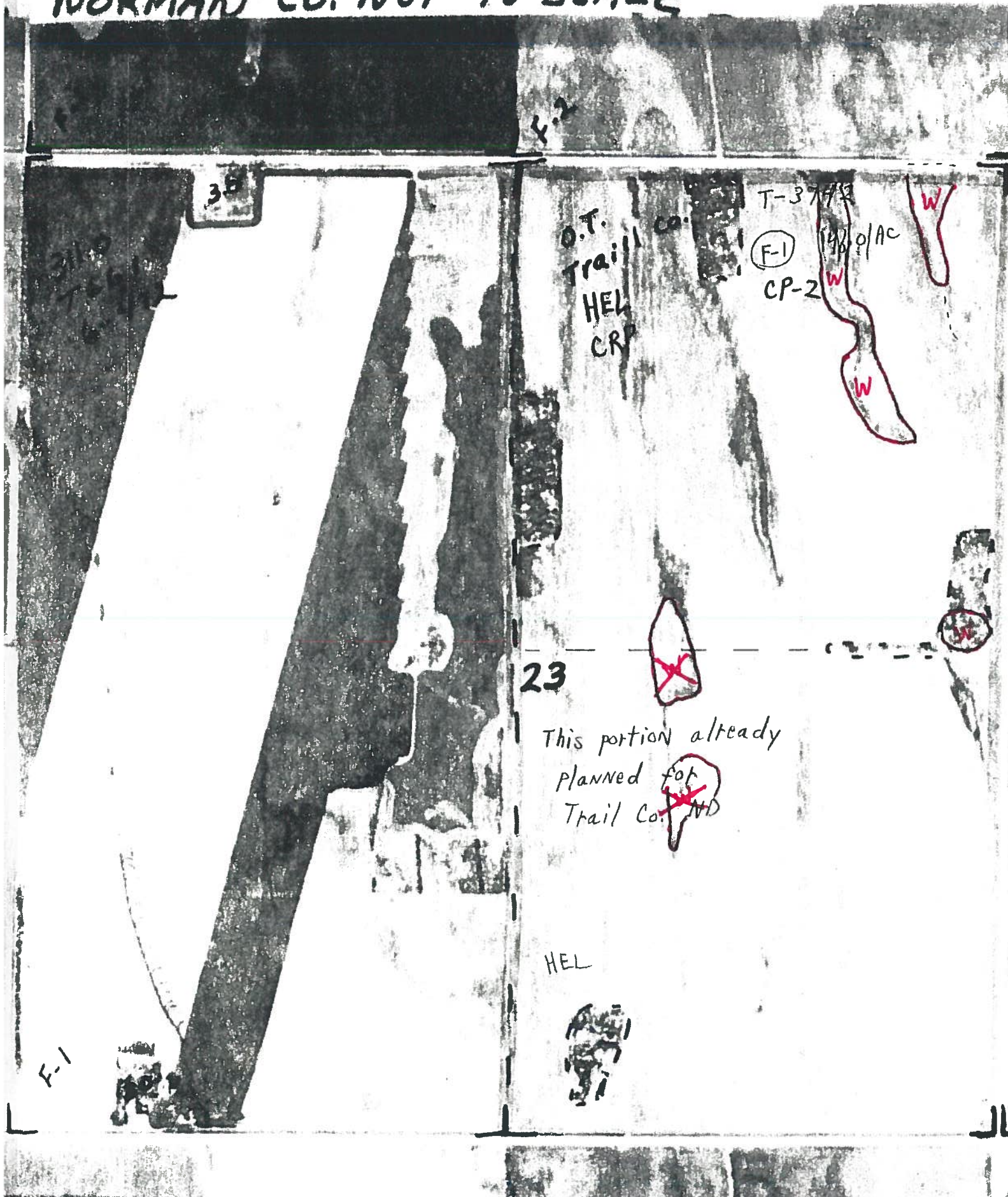
