Auctioneer's Note: Early 2025 opportunity to add a mixed quarter of pasture & cropland to your land holdings southwest of Mohall, North Dakota. 70± acres of pasture is surrounded by 4-wire barbed fence and divided into two paddocks to maximize rotational grazing practices. This fence and paddocks were installed through a cost share program with Duck's Unlimited in 2020. Little Deep Creek traverses across the pasture acres providing for some nature water features for livestock. Unencumbered by US Fish and Wildlife Wetland or Grassland Easements, the remaining cropland acres throughout the quarter may offer several opportunities to cultivate a row crop or additional acres for livestock feed production.


