I/We recognize the statements in the LMGA Rules of Management pages 13 j and 22 A.
as seen below:

(j). The Base Property as determined by the base property study completed September 5, 1989,
as amended from time to time, will stand as the basis for all permits' allocations. All grazing
privileges are attached to the base property, leased or owned. Commensurability requirements
must be met as well as all other rules and regulations governing the requirements for obtaining
and granting of grazing permits.

A. HISTORICAL ATTACHMENT

The grazing permit must have been historically attached to commensurate base property
which is under association control. Control means that the association will annually monitor use
of the base property to assure that stocking rates and overall management maintains
commensurability and provides for development and retention of healthy range conditions which
demonstrate good grassland agriculture. This control must be acknowledged by wording in the
lease.

I/We acknowledge that I/we meet the qualifications set forth in the LMGA Rules of
Management, page 9 as follows:

QUALIFIED APPLICANTS

A qualified applicant shall mean any citizen of the United States or any person who has
filed a declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States, any group, association, or
corporation, whose members meet the preceding citizenship requirements and which is authorized
to do business in the State of North Dakota, providing he, she or it is engaged in the raising of
livestock, for all purposes of these rules, the term livestock shall mean cattle, horses, and sheep.
An applicant must own or lease land within or adjacent to the boundaries of the Association
within the counties involved and depend upon the base ranch, association-controlled lands, and
the permitted livestock as an integral part of his livelihood. An applicant must own or lease base
property to which certain specific grazing privileges are allocated.
