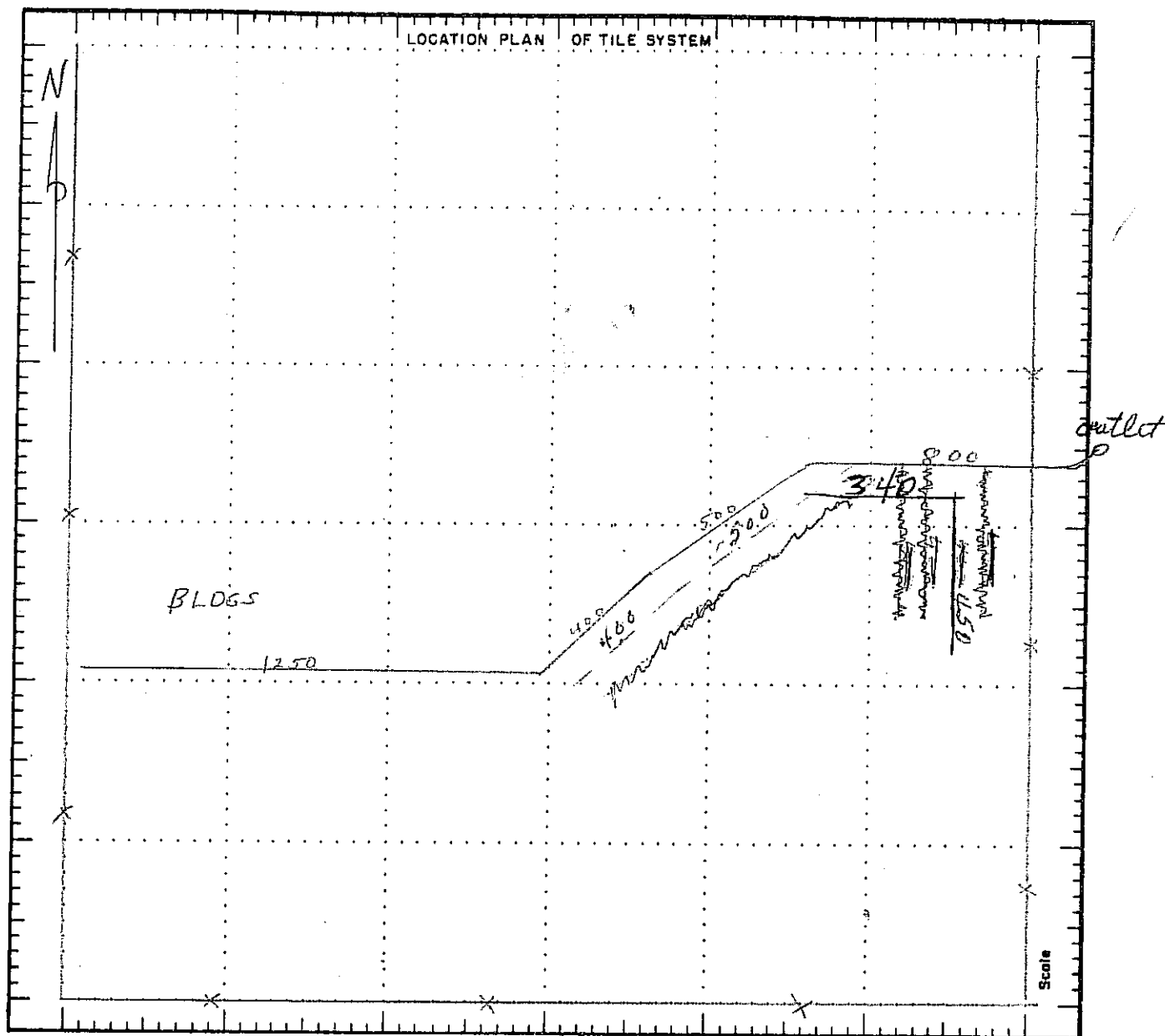

Dear sir:

Your request for Federal cost-sharing under the 196<sup>3</sup> Agricultural Conservation Program in carrying out needed soil or water conservation practices on your farm has been tentatively approved as shown on the attached form 247.


In order to expedite the management of the 196<sup>3</sup> ACP program, it will be necessary for each participant to assume and carry out his responsibilities under the program.

These responsibilities include the following requirements:

1. Notify the Soil Conservation Service, West Union, at least ONE WEEK before starting the establishment of a permanent conservation practice, (Terrace, waterways, structures, drainage ditches, surface drainage ditches, tile and ponds) It is required that the Soil Conservation Service Technicians be given sufficient time to survey, and design the practice before work is started. In the case of tiling where you connect with adjoining farm it will be necessary to obtain an easement from owner and file in Recorder's Office, evidence of such easement must accompany contractors certificate sent to the SCS Office in West Union when work is completed. NO ACP PAYMENT WILL BE MADE UNLESS THESE DIRECTIONS ARE FOLLOWED.
2. The attached CONTRACTOR'S CERTIFICATE must be completely filled out by the Contractor and forwarded by the participant to the SOIL CONSERVATION SERVICE OFFICE, WEST UNION, immediately upon completion of the work. It is required that this certificate be submitted before the Soil Conservation Service Technicians will make a check of the practice and a certification of performance for it.

If no certification of performance is made, there will be no Federal Cost-sharing payment made. If the completed practice does not meet or exceed the specifications in the Iowa ACP Handbook for 196<sup>3</sup>, there will be no Federal Cost-Sharing payment made.
